**RE: Non-Drought Response Level Declaration**

Dear EPD Permit Holder:

As provided for in the Rules for Drought Management, Chapter 391-3-30, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has been monitoring climatic indicators and water supply conditions to assess drought severity and its effects. Drought conditions have improved statewide.

Because of these improvements, I am hereby changing the declared Drought Response Level from Level 1 to a non-drought response level for the counties shown in the enclosed Table 1. A map showing revised drought response levels for the entire state is also enclosed.

Although EPD is easing the outdoor water use restrictions that were implemented during the most recent drought response declaration, Georgians must continue to follow the year-round non-drought outdoor water use schedule required by the Water Stewardship Act. As drought recovery continues, we urge citizens to be good stewards of our water resources.
